Cllr *M Smith*, **A14**: Cllr Smith is having ongoing discussions with the A14 team about the traffic through the villages when the A14 is closed at night. Lack of useful signposting was highlighted: Cllr Smith will feed this back. The Bailey bridge is due to be removed from the Swavesey interchange, involving road closure at Godmanchester and traffic diverted along the A1198. **Notice board:** Cllr Smith advised that the person to speak to about installing the notice board on the verge is James Broden of Highways.
