16/977 The defibrillator is now being installed at the village hall. It needs to be hardwired into the electricity socket. S Gyles will obtain a quotation for this. The clerk will contact a paramedic for a demonstration on how to use the device.

16/1015 Swavesey Spartans has been invoiced.

16/1016 Cost of skate park/zip wire. The cost of a skate park is likely to be prohibitive. Prices in 2007 ranged from £18K to £40K.
